

# Béatrice Belorgey appointed as Chair of the BGL BNP Paribas Executive Committee and Country Head of the Group in Luxembourg

- Béatrice Belorgey has been appointed as Chair of the BGL BNP Paribas Executive Committee and member of the bank's Board of Directors.
- Béatrice Belorgey has also been appointed as Country Head of the BNP Paribas Group in Luxembourg.

At its meeting on 9 July 2020, the Board of Directors of BGL BNP Paribas appointed Béatrice Belorgey as Chair of the bank's Executive Committee. She will also become a director on the bank's Board of Directors. Béatrice Belorgey has also been appointed as Country Head of the BNP Paribas Group in Luxembourg. She replaces Geoffroy Bazin who, in order to pursue new professional challenges, has decided to step down from his roles as Chair of the BGL BNP Paribas Executive Committee, member of the BGL BNP Paribas Board of Directors and Country Head of the BNP Paribas Group in Luxembourg. This appointment is subject to the approval of the national and European regulatory authorities.



As a graduate of the Institut d'Études Politiques de Paris and a Certified European Financial Analyst (CEFA), **Béatrice Belorgey** began her career at BNP Paribas in 1986 as a credit analyst in Retail Banking in France. In 1989, she joined Corporate & Investment Banking (CIB) within the Fixed Income and, later, Corporate Banking teams. In 2000, she moved to Wealth Management as Head of the Financial Product Range and Advisory Desk of the private bank in Luxembourg. In 2005, she was named Head of the Group's Financial Information department and then, in 2009, she took over responsibility for the Group's Investor Relations and Financial Information departments. Since 2013, Béatrice Belorgey has been Head of BNP Paribas Banque Privée France.
