

Mastercard Competition rules 2018

Article 1: Name

BGL BNP Paribas, 50 avenue J.F. Kennedy, L-2951 Luxembourg, is organising a contest entitled “World Mastercard Competition”, hereinafter “the Competition”. The French version “*Règlement du jeu-concours Mastercard 2018*” shall always prevail in case of any discrepancy or inconsistency between French and its English translation.

Article 2: Duration

The Competition shall run from 1 December 2018 to 31 January 2019, inclusive.

Article 3: Entry

The Competition is open to all natural persons who hold a BGL BNP Paribas World Mastercard (i.e. a Mastercard Gold, Gold Priority, Platinum or Elite) and who use this card at least once between 1 December 2018 and 31 January 2019, inclusive. Entrants must provide proof that they hold such a card for the duration of the Competition, as outlined in Article 2 of these rules.

Only one entry will be accepted per person.

It is strictly prohibited to modify or to attempt to modify the rules of this Competition by any means whatsoever, in particular with the intention of changing the results or influencing through automated or unfair means the validity of the prize draw or the naming of the winners.

Entrants to this Competition are assumed to have read and accepted these rules. Failure to comply with the entry conditions stipulated in these rules shall result in disqualification.

Article 4: Modifications

BGL BNP Paribas reserves the right to extend, suspend or postpone the Competition referred to in Article 1 at any time and without notice. It cannot be held liable in this regard by entrants or any other party.

Article 5: Liability

In the event that BGL BNP Paribas cancels the Competition, it shall not be held liable for any consequences that may arise as a result of this decision.

Moreover, BGL BNP Paribas shall not be held liable for technical problems of any kind.

BGL BNP Paribas shall not be held liable for any cancellation, nor for any direct or indirect damages suffered by the winner and/or any third party.

Article 6: Purpose

The Competition shall run between 1 December 2018 and 31 January 2019 with the purpose of awarding the prizes described in Article 7.



Five winners will be chosen at random from among the entrants. These five winners will each be awarded the prize mentioned in Article 7.

BGL BNP Paribas undertakes not to publish the names of the winners without their prior written consent.

Article 7: Prizes

The purpose of the Competition is to award EUR 2,500 each to five different BGL BNP Paribas Optiflex current accounts.

Article 8: Award of prizes

The five winners will be chosen at random by means of a prize draw on Monday, 4 February 2019 from the list of clients who used their BGL BNP Paribas World Mastercard between 1 December 2018 and 31 January 2019. The prize draw will be carried out by BGL BNP Paribas. The winners will each be notified by BGL BNP Paribas by registered post. Only one entry will be accepted per person.

Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.

If the selected winner does not respond within 20 calendar days of the registered letter being sent, they will be deemed to have refused their prize and the prize will remain the property of BGL BNP Paribas

Article 9: Distribution of prizes

BGL BNP Paribas will credit EUR 2,500 to the BGL BNP Paribas Optiflex current accounts of each of the five winners.

The prizes may not under any circumstances be credited to another BGL BNP Paribas account, nor replaced or exchanged for cash.

Article 12: Applicable law and jurisdiction

The courts of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any disputes that may arise regarding this Contest. Nonetheless, the Bank reserves the right to file a claim with the courts of any other jurisdiction that, failing the election of jurisdiction set out above, would normally have jurisdiction over entrants.
