“Job starter – first job Luxembourg” competition rules

Article 1: Name

BGL BNP Paribas, 50 avenue J.F. Kennedy – L-2951 Luxembourg, is organising a competition entitled “**Job starter – first job Luxembourg**”.

Article 2: Term

The competition “**Job starter – first job Luxembourg**” runs from 22 August to 5 september 2017 inclusive.

Article 3: Entering the competition

The competition is open to all young professionals, under a Luxembourgish contract and aged **under 30**. Winners will be asked to provide proof of their employment contract and their identity card. Only one entry will be accepted per person.

Entering the competition implies acceptance of these rules. Any failure to comply with the entry conditions stipulated in these rules will result in the entry being declared null and void.

Article 4: Modification

BGL BNP Paribas reserves the right to extend, suspend or interrupt the competition named in Article 1 at any time, without prior warning. It cannot be held liable in this regard by participants or any other parties.

Article 5: Liability

In the event that the competition is cancelled by BGL BNP Paribas, it cannot be held liable in any way for any consequences resulting from this decision. Furthermore, BGL BNP Paribas cannot be held liable in the event of technical difficulties of any kind.

Any disputes that may arise regarding the competition shall be heard exclusively in the courts of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. Nonetheless, the Bank may file a claim with the courts of any other jurisdiction, which failing the election of jurisdiction set out above, would normally have jurisdiction with regard to the participant.
