History:

Banca Nazionale del Lavoro originated from Istituto Nazionale di Credito per la Cooperazione founded in 1913 to support financially the commercial and production activities of the associations following the strong growth of the cooperative movement at the beginning of the century.

At the end of the 40's, its activities started to include operations of particular public interest, entrusted to it by the government.

In 1992, BNL transformation from a public entity to a joint-stock company - Banca Nazionale del Lavoro Spa - was completed.

In 1998 BNL went on the market and entered in the MIB30 the Milan Stock Exchange.

In 2006 the bank entered the BNP Paribas Group.
